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I am directed to enclose the application of Akshara Public School (English Medium), Kakinada, to the Secretary, Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi and to state that this State Government have no objection to accord affiliation to it subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions:-

- 1) The State Government reserves the right to withdraw the above certificate at any time if the Management fails to comply with the instructions of the State Government such as (a) removal of teachers, non-payment of salaries to the teaching and non-teaching staff as per the approved scales etc.
- 2) Admissions should be made with the bonafide date of birth certificate.
- 3) All the un-trained teachers should be replaced by the trained teachers.
- 4) The Management should collect the Tuition Fee and Special Fee etc., as prescribed by Government from time to time.
- 5) The strength in classes should be as per rules in force.
- 6) The Management should follow the State syllabus for Classes from I to V.
- 7) The School should follow the three language formula.

- 8) The District Educational Officer or his nominee should be invited when the Management makes recruitment of ~~recruitment of the school staff and other staff~~
- 9) Staff salaries should be paid as per Government scales
- 10) Day facilities should be provided
- 11) The Management should not collect donations either from students or parents for admissions
- 12) The Management should implement the Teachers' Provident Fund Scheme, and
- 13) No pupil studying in the School should be put to hard-work for continuing in the same school.
